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Potential Diabetes Research Participant Questionnaire

Thank you for your interest in clinical research at Mountain Diabetes & Endocrine Center. Below are some preliminary questions that will help us determine what studies might be available for you to participate in. Please answer them truthfully and to the best of your ability. Different studies have very different participation criteria, so there are no “right” or “wrong” answers; the information you provide simply helps guide us on how to serve you best.

1. Do you have type 1 or type 2 diabetes? (If you are not sure: How old were you when you were diagnosed with diabetes? Were you treated with insulin when you were first diagnosed? Were you ever in ketoacidosis (DKA)?)
2. What medications do you take for diabetes?
3. Do you use insulin? What kind(s) of insulin do you use? How many units do you use per day?
4. How do you take your insulin (e.g. pens, shots, pump, inhaled insulin)?
5. Do you wear a continuous glucose monitor? If so, what manufacturer is it from?
6. Can you feel any symptoms of hypoglycemia? Have you passed out during, or needed help treating, an episode of hypoglycemia in the past 6 months?
7. Do you have any complications of diabetes (eye, kidney, nerve, or vascular damage)?
8. Have you had a heart attack in the past 6 months?
9. Have you been treated for cancer in the past 5 years?
10. Do you have any serious medical illnesses other than diabetes?
11. Do you need to take glucocorticoids (e.g. prednisone or cortisone) more than a few days per year?
